1. EICs are set up for early detection and intervention of development delay and disabilities in children in the age group of 0-6 years with the aim to reduce disease burden and enhance functional capabilities of children with disabilities and improve the quality of life of these children and their families.

2. To provide timely and comprehensive diagnostic, rehabilitative and therapeutic services to the differently abled children in pursuit of making them independent and helping them contribute to the progress of the society.

3. Services being provided at EICs are Pediatric Neurology, Neonatology Pediatric Ophthalmology, Pediatric Dentistry, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language Therapy, Special Education, Behavior Therapy, Dietary Services and Oto-acoustic Emission Test (OAE).

Through these services development disabilities like Intellectual disabilities, Cerebral palsy, Autism spectrum disorder, Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder (ADHD), Delayed development in motor skills, language and speech and thinking ability, epilepsy, Global Developmental Delay (GDD), Down syndrome, genetic disorder, prematurity, hemiplegia, quadriplegia, Learning Disabilities, behavioral disorder, depression are treated.
